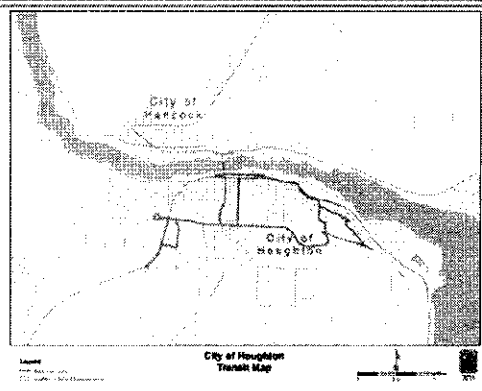
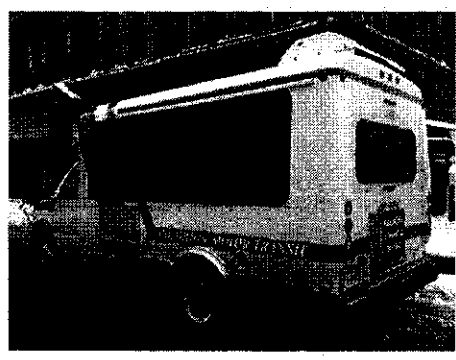

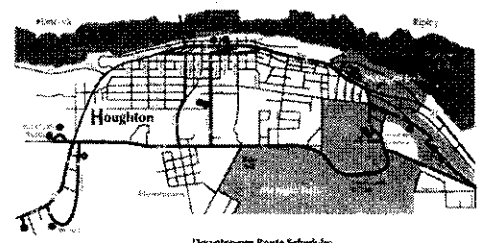
Transit Provider Information

The flex route, known as the Downtowner, operates from 10 am to 5 pm and connects three main areas: Michigan Tech, Downtown Houghton, and the M-26 shopping area in western Houghton.

Houghton Motor Transit also offers special services for community events such as Bridgefest. These routes are announced as available and fares are free.

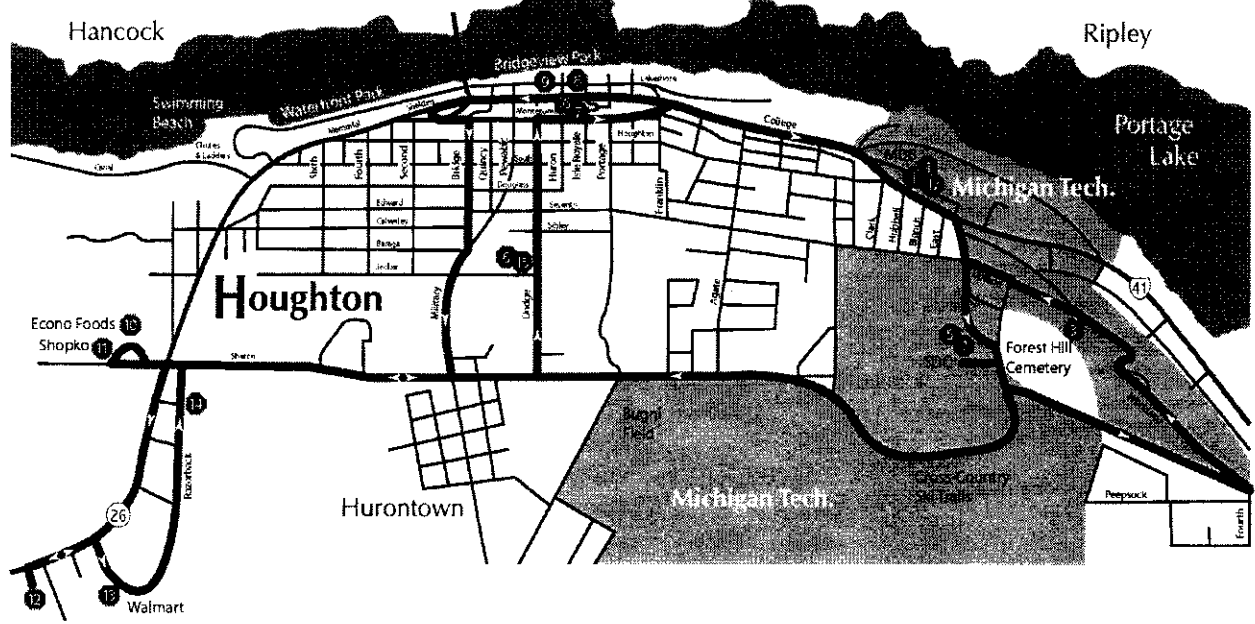
