## **Hoop House Workshop**

The Main Street Calumet Market will host the third in its series of free public workshops on Wednesday, January 25, 2012 at the Village of Calumet Council Chambers (located in the Calumet Theatre building), 340 Sixth Street, Calumet, Michigan 49913 at 6:00 p.m. Kelly Cantway, Special Projects Coordinator with the Marquette Food Co-op, will conduct the workshop which is based on her experience working on five hoop house projects in Marquette County.

Hoop houses are unheated greenhouses that are gaining popularity, with individual and commercial producers, as a way to protect plants from harsh weather conditions, extend local growing seasons and consequently increase a producer's output and income. Ms. Cantway's presentation will cover a variety of topics including how to get started with financial assistance, hoop house construction, and the potential to harvest and market produce year round.
