

The Main Street Calumet Market Is Moving Outdoors

On Saturday, June 16, 2012 the Main Street Calumet Market is heading outdoors to its summer location in Agassiz Park, at the intersection of Fourth and Portland Streets, directly behind the Merchants and Miners Bank Building in downtown Calumet, Michigan. The summer hours will be 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. every Saturday. The market will offer seasonal fruits and vegetables, the works of local artisans and craft people, as well as quality products made by area businesses.

The market is also issuing a call to local produce growers interested in participating as vendors. They will be provided 1 open sided canopy (10' X 10'), 1 table (6' X 2.5') and 1 chair. Optional space and equipment requirements can be negotiated with the market manager. Set up time is from 8:00 a.m. to 8:45 a.m. With the exception of a \$3.00 charge for anyone requiring electricity, there is no vendor.
