NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Hancock will hold a Public Hearing at 7:30 p.m., Wednesday, November 18, 2015 at City Hall, 399 Quincy Street, Hancock, Michigan on a proposed new grant application and to close out an existing MSHDA grant.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive public input on the submission of a grant application to the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA). The City of Hancock intends to apply for an \$188,000 Rental Rehabilitation Grant through the Michigan State Housing Development Authority. The proposed project would provide assistance to approximately 4 existing apartments in underutilized space above commercial space at 101 Quincy Street, Hancock, Michigan.

Public input is requested on the completion of a Rental Rehabilitation Grant #MSC 2012-0567-HO through the Michigan State Housing Development Authority for the creation of 2 new apartments in vacant space and rehabbing 7 existing apartments located above commercial areas in downtown Hancock in the amount of \$346,000, including 234 Quincy Street, 308 Quincy Street and 326 Quincy Street.
