
Attention Hancock Residents: Update

New Pick Up Schedule

Waste Management Garbage and Recycling - Starts Monday, September 12th

- All items need to be out by 7am
- -Weekly same day pick up for garbage and recycling (using a new dual garbage truck)
- -Pick Up Day Change (collection will be two days a week) : This affects some neighborhoods
 - -East of Elevation Street will be on Monday
 - -West of Elevation Street will be on Wednesday
- *Pick up for residents living on Elevation, S. Elevation and N. Elevation Streets will be on WEDNESDAY.
- -Any container will work some people are painting or taping (recycling) on the bins they now use or you can purchase a new recycling bin from McGann's or Risto's.
- -Single stream will continue for all items including glass and clean pizza boxes!
- -Service is also available to small commercial.
- -The City will still have a recycling drop off at the DPW Garage (1601 Tomasi Drive)

Beginning Monday, September 12, 2016

Place ALL your CLEAN recyclables in a reusable CONTAINER
Recyclables can be mixed within the container

DO NOT PLACE IN PLASTIC BAG

Accepted items:

- PLASTICS #1 thru #8
- Aluminum cans, tin cans, jar lids and foil products only
- Corrugated Cardboard (empty/flattened)
- Cereal box type cardboard (remove inner Packaging)empty/flattened
- Soft drink or beer cartons empty/flattened
- White boxboard or card stock
- Newspapers and inserts
- Magazines and Catalogs
- Paper bags or other brown paper empty
- Plastic bags (grocery store bags)empty
- Gray paperboard, boxboard egg cartons
- Junk Mail
- Envelopes (labels and windows OK)
- Telephone Books
- Packing Paper (NO Tissue)
- Soft cover computer manuals
- Dark colored accordion files
- Manila file folders
- Paperback Books
- Hard Cover Books
- Glass and Clean Pizza Boxes

-Newspapers, plastic jugs, and cardboard may be tied or bundled-

Leaves & Grass Clippings in Hancock's Green Bio Bags are accepted at the compost pile at the Department of Public Works Monday-Friday 7—3 pm
Do not leave clear or other plastic bags at the compost pile.
Businesses & Residents may bring Cardboard & Recycling to the DPW
